

Traditional Dice- Music Game

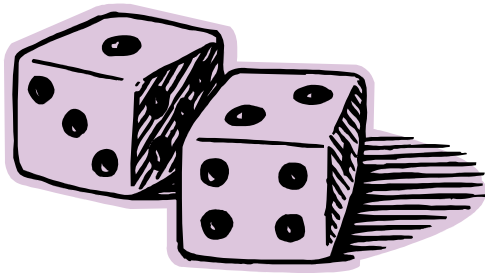
Materials: 2 regular six sided dice and paper.

The play:

Make a list numbered 1 – 10 (list is one number for each line)

Shake the dice and write down the number on each die:

Translate those numbers into note values:



In this example there is a 1 and a 2

You would draw the note values: 1= ♩ and 2= ♪



If the 5 or 6 is shaken, you have to break those down to create one note plus a **rest** to add up to 5 or 6.

Example: 5 could equal (4) ♩ + (1) ♩ for a total of 5

This is good practice to see if you can quickly translate note values into note shapes.

Try doing 10 and see how many you get correct.
